- the pediatric medicine, surgery, research and residency programs for the UAB School of Medicine.
- the only international adoption center to have a partnership with the Chinese government.

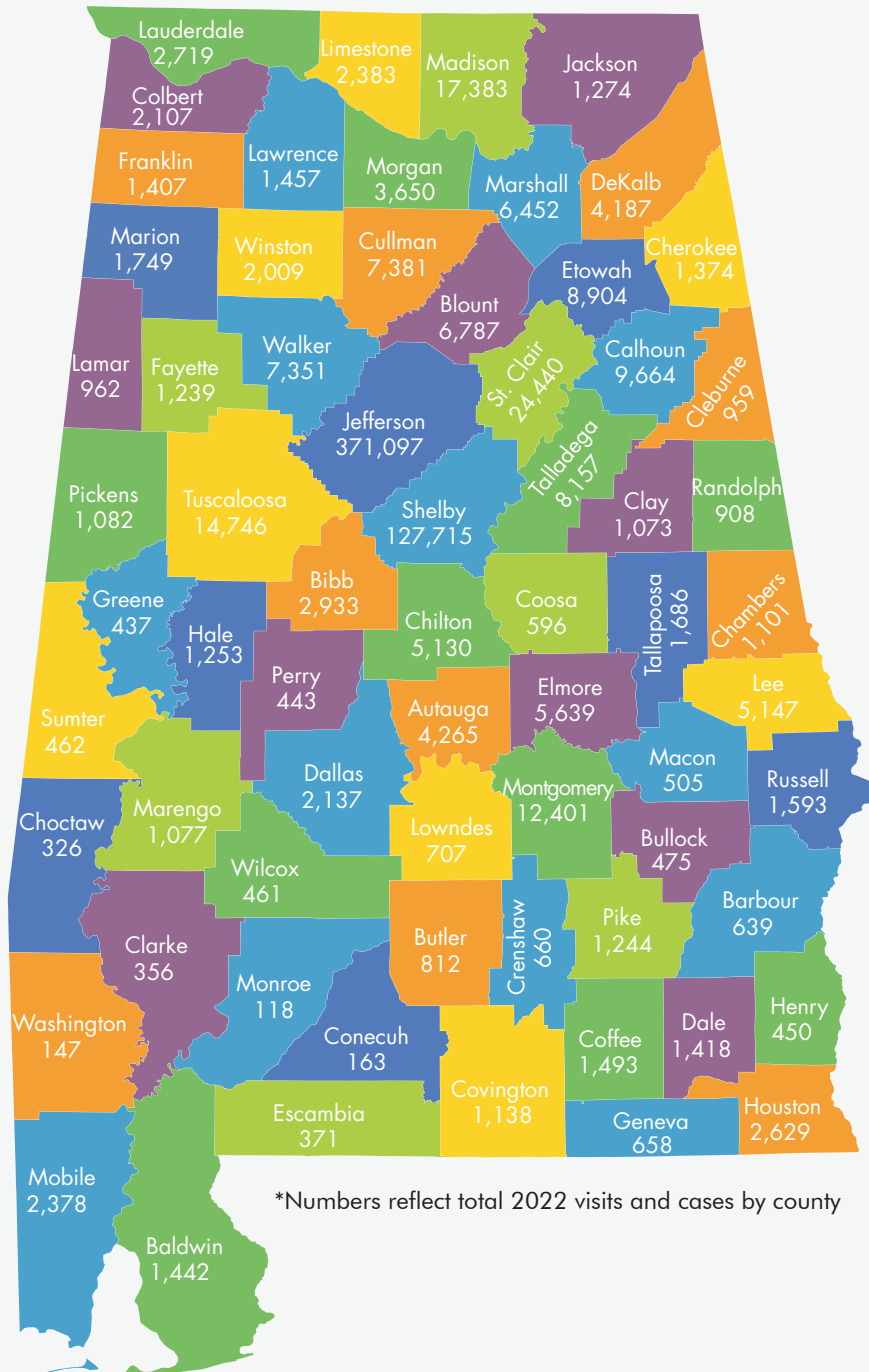
